

**CESA 8 JOB OPENING  
PART-TIME OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST**

**SUMMARY:**

Assess, plan, organize, and participate in rehabilitative programs that help build or restore vocational, homemaking, and daily living skills, as well as general independence, to persons with disabilities or developmental delays.

Part-time (temporary) opportunity starting in the spring of 2024 in the Crivitz school district, through a cooperative service arrangement with CESA 8. A Part-time Occupational Therapist provides therapy services to students in a K-12 setting which will enable them to benefit from comprehensive special education programs.

**JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Incorporate motor goals into the educational curriculum.
- Support the Special Ed program of students by ensuring the necessary adaptations, equipment, assistive technology, information and training.
- Assist in the integration and inclusion of students into the classroom.
- Must be an active participant of the educational team by sharing information, problem-solving and supporting other disciplines.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Looking for a highly motivated, team-oriented person who has the necessary skills, interest, and ability to work with students and staff.
- Deliver occupational therapy to students who qualify for the children with disabilities program having been identified by an Individual Education Program (IEP) Team.
- Must have excellent diagnostic evaluation skills, IEP reporting skills, and be an effective team member.
- Experience in a school setting is a plus.
